## **2022 Inspection Payment Voucher**

Michigan Tree Farm Committee pays certified Tree Farm Inspectors for conducting a <u>field inspection</u>. Payment will be made even if the property is moved to Pioneer or De-Certified. Payment will not be made for phone or email inspections - only on-site inspections.

Initial inspections (new Tree Farmers) will be reimbursed at \$100. If an initial inspection is done with a forest stewardship plan, this \$100 may be paid by the DNR. Do NOT use this form if you have requested the \$100 from the DNR with a forest stewardship plan. All other initial inspections will be paid by Tree Farm.

Re-inspections of current Tree Farmers (required, optional, or voluntary) will be reimbursed at \$200 for private sector foresters and \$100 for government foresters.
